We have traveled to affected areas (the projects in Coney Island, Breezy Point and the Rockaways... which included visiting FEEMA sites and food pantries the day before Thanksgiving) to help animals left behind, and also distribute food. We have taken animals in from the Town of Hempstead NY Animal Shelter. (see attached PDF of the email requesting help.) We have also taken additional animals in for adoption. We recently took in 5 adult cats and 2 kittens from Red Hook which is an area that is still severely impacted by Hurricane Sandy. We are	



	The only active fundraising we did was on our website. You can see photos of donations received by the Humane Society of New York from the Red Cross and Lexington Hospital for Cats, Lexington, KY. You can also see photos of the HSNY distributing food and litter to those in need, animals that were saved, animals that were boarded, animals that received medical care. We have a PayPal donation button on our website and that is the only active fundraising we did. We were invited to make some television appearances to let people know we could help their animals in our hospital, and to talk about the work we were doing, but we did not ask people to send us money.
10.	Is your organization still conducting relief efforts? If so, please describe how individuals, businesses or organizations seeking assistance can contact your organization.
	We still see people that come to HSNY's clinic for essential medical care they cannot afford to pay for and we underwrite the cost. Just recently, 3/13/13, we helped 3 cats with emergency care, including an emergency dental procedure, that are still being fostered because their human companion still doesn't have a place to live. Those in need can contact us at (212) 752-4842 and let us know if their animal has a medical emergency they cannot afford to pay for because they are still suffering hardship due to Hurricane Sandy. A lot of people are still rebuilding or relocating and suffering hardship.
