| Please describe the types of assistance that your organization has provided to those affected by Hurricane Sandy. | As of February 25, 2014 All Hands Volunteers has provided free muck, gut, and debris removal services to 313 families through the in field management and coordination of over 3202 volunteers. The estimated value of this service is roughly \$1,484,393. We have provided free services to affected communities on Staten Island, Long Beach, Island Park, Cedarhurst, Massapequa, Atlantic Beach, Valley Stream, Woodmere and Freeport, NY. All Hands also initiated a mold treatment program for the above mentioned communities and have treated over 135 homes for mold. Our Repair/Rebuild program started in July of 2013 and includes installing subfloors, insulation, drywall, lite framing, window installation, mudding and tapping and interior painting. To date All Hands has helped 30 families rebuild/repair their homes. |
