1.	What is the approximate dollar amount of donations and pledges that your organization has received to date in response to Hurricane Sandy?
Approximately \$800,000	
2.	Will these funds be used solely for Hurricane Sandy relief? If not, approximately what portion will be used for Hurricane Sandy relief and what other purposes will funds be used for?
<p>The unused portion of funds raised online will be offered back to those online donors as per our Money Back Guarantee policy; unreclaimed online funds will then be moved into our general disaster response fund.</p> <p>Restricted funds donated for Sandy through other means will be used for continued operations in NY and NJ, as well as to provide targeted grants to adjacent organizations who are maintaining continued operations. Thus far Team Rubicon has distributed funds to Friends of Rockaways, and in kind contributions to NY Cares and Americorps. Discussions with other organizations are taking place.</p>	
3.	Approximately how much has your organization spent to date on Hurricane Sandy relief?
Approximately \$270,000	
4.	What services has your organization provided to those affected by Hurricane Sandy? What populations or geographical areas are being served by your organization in response to Hurricane Sandy? What services does it expect to provide in the future?
<p>Team Rubicon operated almost exclusively in New Jersey and Rockaways, NY. In Rockaways, Team Rubicon conducted extensive disaster assessments and muck out jobs, completing over 900 work orders. Moving into the future, Team Rubicon is looking to identify a long term partner that it can work with in further disaster recovery operations in Rockaways.</p>

Additionally, TR is willing to provide financial assistance to organizations that it feels are adequately and efficiently meeting the needs of the community.</p> <p>Any funds not distributed or spent for Hurricane Sandy will be restricted funding to increasing the operational capacity of Team Rubicon's future disaster response operations.</p>
