	\$31,000 in miscellaneous contributions from individuals and businesses In addition, the Foundation will be making its own grant of up to \$250,000 based on need/demand
2.	Will these funds be used solely for Hurricane Sandy relief? If not, approximately what portion will be used for Hurricane Sandy relief and what other purposes will funds be used for?
	Yes
3.	Approximately how much has your organization spent to date on Hurricane Sandy relief?
	\$130,000
4.	What services has your organization provided to those affected by Hurricane Sandy? What populations or geographical areas are being served by your organization in response to Hurricane Sandy? What services does it expect to provide in the future?
	Provided \$1000 each in assistance to employees whose cars were either destroyed or swept away at our facilities in Manhattan Beach and Coney Island during the two days of Sandy when they continued to work serving their patients. MJHS provides Homecare, Hospice and Palliative Care services to people in the 5 boros as well as Nassau. These services will continue in the future.
5.	Has your organization provided funding to other organizations for Hurricane Sandy relief efforts? If so, which organizations have received those funds and what is the approximate

	dollar amount provided to them? How does your organization determine the need for funding?
	No
