We have paid for the care of animals displaced by the hurricane (vet fees, temporary boarding, transport of animals to rescue groups, etc.). We have also provided financial assistance to animal welfare organizations that incurred extraordinary costs as a result of the hurricane and its related effects. We have also received donated animal food and pet supplies, and have arranged for these items to be distributed to pet owners and their pets, primarily on Staten Island. Our services have been primarily provided to pets, pet owners and animal welfare organizations primarily in the New York metro area, including southern Connecticut and northern New Jersey, as well as to a few organizations outside the tri-state area that accepted animals that needed to be relocated from the tri-state area due to the effects of Hurricane Sandy.
