DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS	
Please describe the types of assistance that your organization has provided to those affected by Hurricane Sandy.	<p>We created three priorities for assistance: In the short term, assistance for displaced people and those living without power; in the medium term, restoration of health services, particularly for the most vulnerable; in the long term, providing mental health and case management services and helping health care institutions prepare for future events. We provided assistance to affected areas primarily in New York, New Jersey and Connecticut. Examples of aid provided:</p> <p>Providing our mobile medical health clinic to disrupted healthcare facilities to help ensure continuity of operations.</p> <p>Hygiene supplies, cleaning supplies</p> <p>Sleeping bags, blankets</p> <p>Vaccines (tetanus and flu)</p> <p>Medicines and medical supplies- insulin, glucometers and strips, acetaminophen, ibuprofen, cough medicine, etc.</p> <p>Special needs cots, wheelchairs, and other functional needs support supplies.</p> <p>Grants (described further in ôGrantsö section)</p>
