Hurricane Sandy Relief Information

Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers Foundation

1. To date, our organization has received donations and pledges of approximately 4 million dollars.
2. These funds will be used solely for Hurricane Sandy Relief.
3. To date, we have spent approximately \$400000.
4. Our organization has supplied hot food, clothing, and supplies to families in the A Zone. We have also organized teams to help with cleaning and partial demolition for more than 1000 homes affected by the storm. We have set up distribution centers to service those affected in Staten Island, Red Hook, Gerritsen Beach, The Rockaways, Long Beach and parts of New Jersey. We will continue to operate these centers until they are no longer needed. We will be providing temporary housing for 10-35 families (depending on need) for up to one year. In addition, we will be providing home repair supplies for those planning to rebuild. We hope to reach over ten thousand families impacted by the storm.
5. We have provided funding of \$25000 to the Friends of Firefighters Organization to help them with their relief efforts. We received a written grant request for this money.
6. We do not anticipate handing out cash or checks in the relief effort. We will however, distribute gift cards (Probably Home Depot) to owners of Yellow Tagged homes, in an effort to help them move forward. We expect to spend up to \$2.5 million dollars on this program.
7. Our plan is to disburse 100% of funds raised for Sandy Relief on victims of the hurricane.
