	<p>ICNA Relief USA has provided Mass Feeding including Zabiha-Halal Hot Meals and Distribution of Critically Needed Supplies (cleaning supplies, electric heaters, blankets, ethnic clothing, etc.); provided free Medical Services, and including OTC medicines and referrals to local emergency rooms; Mucking and Gutting Out services including Mold Remediation/Prevention; Chain Saw and Debris Removal services; and Disaster Case Work, including I&R (Information & Referrals). We have provide services in Brighton Beach/ Brooklyn, Far Rockaways/Queens, Staten Island, and Long Beach/Long Island. We expect to transition Disaster Case Work into long term Disaster Case Management, as long as agency capacity will allow.</p>
