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DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS	
Please describe the types of assistance that your organization has provided to those affected by Hurricane Sandy.	After landfall, Samaritan's Purse engaged in cleanup efforts in Nassau County, NY, and Ocean, Monmouth, Bergen and Atlantic counties in NJ. This work included tarping roofs, conducting mudouts of flooded homes and assisting with removal of personal items. In early 2013, efforts transitioned to long- term efforts. Rebuild field offices were established in Nassau County, NY and Ocean County, NJ. Since then, the work of remodeling damaged homes and rebuilding destroyed homes has been ongoing. In addition, homeowners needing their homes raised or demolished have received these services through the work of Samaritan's Purse. Another project has been a church grant program which has granted monetary funds to Christian Evangelical churches and organizations in NY and NJ damaged during Hurricane Sandy.
